- VariBraille allows you to select the firmness of the braille display.

The Focus displays come with a handsome carrying case and a keyboard stand/handle that can be used to set a keyboard or laptop close to the braille display and can be angled for the greatest comfort. Fold the stand, and the FOCUS goes with you.
